

## **Vähä-Hisso estate**

Vähä-Hisso estate is located in Vammala, in the village of Kutala, on the shore of the beautiful Lake Kulovesi. Distances: Tampere 40 km, Turku 140 km and Helsinki 210 km

### **Presentation:**

Vähä-Hisso estate is family owned since the 1800's; the estate has been cattle, grain cultivation and forestry farm and for the last 35 years pigs have been raised until the year 2003, whereupon production animals were given up. Tourism has been practised since the year 2000.

### **Cottages**

We rent cottages for 6-(8) persons on the shore of Lake Kulovesi both on a weekly basis and for weekends, in summer only on a weekly basis. The cottages are provided by electric heating and a fireplace.

The cottages are equipped with: electric cooker, refrigerator/freezer, micro wave oven, coffee maker, toaster, dishwasher, TV, videos, radio/cd player, washing machine, coal grill on the terrace, tableware, mattresses, blankets and cushions.

Each cottage has its own beach, quay and rowing boat, Keltasirkku and Punatulkku also have a separate lakeside sauna which is used during summertime.

Keltasirkku: 72 m<sup>2</sup> + terrace 2 bedrooms, loft, kitchen, living room, sauna, wash room, WC and storeroom.

Viherpeippo: 81 m<sup>2</sup> + terrace 2 bedrooms, loft, kitchen, living room, sauna, wash room, dressing room, WC and storeroom.)

### **Saunas:**

A small log building, which acts as a wedding suite, is located on the cliff. It is nice to jump into Lake Kulovesi after the sweet steams of the lakeside sauna, whether it be summer or winter. In the lakeside sauna there is place for about 6 persons and for 20 persons in the smoke sauna.

### **Meetings:**
